De-monetization in India, old crop auctions from Thailand, an upcoming winter-spring crop in Vietnam and Myanmar's own improved crop seek buyers to drive exports, and China, Africa, key Southeast Asian markets like Philippines, Indonesia and Malaysia offer fresh potential for a rising Myanmar rice export. Is Myanmar only a cheap rice producer and exporter? There are efforts in place to raise standards, improve milling, even create a more consistent production as part of a multi-pronged effort that involves the government and private sector, working in tangent to raise Myanmar's value as a rice exporter, add export diversity and raise Myanmar's position in global rice exports.

Myanmar is also moving to develop logistics, streamline its supply chain and help improve its access to markets.
